The purpose of this Offis Privacy Policy is to disclose how Offis Pty Ltd ("Offis", "us" or "we") collects, protects and uses the personal data of its customers, users, and visitors to the offis.com.au website. Offis (ABN 70 077 283 811) is committed to ensuring that any personal data supplied or otherwise generated by our business activities through our products and services is collected and processed fairly and in accordance with appropriate data protection and privacy laws including the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

By providing your personal data to us, you are consenting to this Privacy Policy and the collection, use, access, transfer, storage and processing of your personal information as described in this policy.

Types of Personal Data We Collect

We collect information that may be used to personally identify you ("Personal Data") including, but not limited to the following:

- 1. Your usernames and passwords which provide you with access to your profile areas and to protected content and information systems;

- 3. Your contact information such as your contact name, mailing addresses, phone numbers, fax numbers, and email addresses:

- 5. Your responses to surveys and customer feedback requests;
- 6. Information exchange over email correspondence, including raised issues and enquiries of all types;
- 7. Your credit or debit card information and billing information, including name of cardholder, company name, card number, billing address and expiry date.

Purpose for Collection and Use of Personal Data

We may use the Personal Data provided for one or more of the following purposes:

- 1. For the supply of any products and/or services which we may offer to you or you may require from us including text message (SMS) and email alerts;
- 2. For marketing, promotional and customer relationship management purposes, such as sending you updates on latest offerings and promotions in connection with our products and services;
- 3. For identification and verification purposes in connection with any of the services or products that may be supplied to vou:
- 4. To contact you regarding your enquiries;
- 5. To disclose to a third party to comply with any law, legal requirements, orders, directions or requests from any court, authority or government body of any jurisdiction;
- 6. To improve on the level and type of service we provide to customers;
- 7. To facilitate the payment for products and services provided by us, including verification of credit card details with third parties and using the Personal Data you provide to conduct matching procedures against databases of known fraudulent transactions (maintained by us or third parties).

Except for those uses provided above, we will not knowingly or intentionally use or share the Personal Data you provide to use in ways unrelated to the aforementioned purposes without your prior consent.

How Personal Data is Collected

Offis collects Personal Data in a number of different ways, including from existing and prospective customer enquiries, orders placed by customers, marketing events or campaigns, vendors, contractors, or employment applicants.
